Previous Minutes

The Minutes from the meeting on the 14th of February 2024 were approved by the committee.

IGC Plenary

BS reported on the decisions of the IGC Plenary in Toulouse on 2nd March:

- * Requirement for Strobes approved and to be considered for adoption in the UK
- * PEV / circle starts were adopted but there is no scoring software available to score them. SC3A has been amended but there are still ongoing discussions on implementation. This is already to be considered in the UK
- * Club class handicaps changed. We will review
- * 14th FAI JWGC 2026 to be in Aalen, Germany
- * 24th FAI EGC 2026 (Club, Standard, 15M) to be in Ostrow, Poland
- * 41st FAI WGC 2027 (Club, Standard, 15m) to be in Italy
- * 14th FAI WWGC 2027 to be in Celje, Slovenia
- *15th FAI JWGC 2028 to be in Australia. CC will consider whether / how to support this competition.

2025 Competition Calendar

JW presented a detailed report on the difficulties in selecting clubs for 2025 Nationals competitions. There were few bids and one club made bids that did not meet our requirements. This had left us little choice. JW and RS considered this during our off season and following significant arm twisting awarded the following venues and dates:

Team Voting

JW expressed a view that the process was unnecessarily complicated and prone to error. He will bring forward a proposal to review the whole selection process for 2027.

ICL Report

CL presented a report on ICL 2024 and in particular the lack of attendance at the Final. He felt the cup should be awarded to Hus Bos by default as they were the only team willing to appear at the Final. The matter had been contested by Essex, who did not send a team. There was agreement that if only one team turn up, they win by default. CL proposed rule changes for 2025 to emphasise this point and to clarify the rules where a club has no regional competitors. These proposed changes were approved.

Proposal to increase the number of pilots for the WWGC

FR presented a proposal to permanently increase the entries to WWGC to 6 (2 in each class). Following discussion about funding this was agreed in principle and will be included in the rules for 2025. There will be further discussion about budgets at a later meeting.

CC Tasks 2025

JW presented a tasks spreadsheet with timeframes for the work that the CC needs to deliver in the 2024/25 round of meetings. JW asked all to review and identify any items that may be missing or incorrect. FR offered to collate and summarise the Director's reports for consideration by the rules sub-committee. FR will join RC,PC, and JW on this group.

- * PC said that he would try to publish the 2024 ratings by 7th October.
- * BS suggested that we have at least one face to face meeting this round
- * RS / BS suggested we shuffle meeting times to include a weekend afternoon
- * JW thanked the whole committee for their support for the 2024/25 round of decision making
